1000 (Latin for "Totally Yours") is a Catholic youth program dedicated

to sharing the Gospel and promoting the Catholic faith through catechesis,

evangelization, Christian witness, and Eucharistic worship. The goal of Totus Tuus is to help young people grow in the understanding of, and strengthen their faith in, Jesus Christ. "I am the way, the truth and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me" (John 4:16).

The Grade School Program is designed for Catholic children going into First through Sixth grades. The program strives to:

> help students be clear and consistent in their faith, and show the children that the humble yet courageous seeking of all believers is to be based upon the Word of God


The *Program for Secondary Students, Totus Tuus Primetime*, is for Catholic youth going into 7th through 12th grades, and includes instruction, large and small group discussions, quiet meditation, skits, subject-related activities, and prayer and fellowship.

The *teachers* for the **Totus Tuus** program are college age students, two men and two women. (Generally, at least one of the men is a seminarian)

There are *five essential elements* to the **Totus Tuus** program:

- 1. Proclamation of the Gospel to arouse faith.
- 2. Apologetics examination of the reasons for our beliefs.
- 3. Christian Witness an experience of Christian living.
- 4. Celebration of the Sacraments-especially Holy Eucharist and Confession.
- 5. Active Witness of the Missionary Nature of the Catholic Church
