

Faith Formation Scholarship Fund

Since the 1980's the Faith Formation Scholarship Program has assisted people across the Diocese of Winona with increasing their knowledge of the Catholic faith to be used in ministry.

The Faith Formation Scholarship Fund seeks to assist those adults who realize the need to increase their knowledge of the faith in order to participate more fully in the life of the This scholarship program Church. assists those who seek undergraduate education in Theology or Pastoral Ministry, those already in ministry who need continuing education, and women who seek to join Endow groups but find the cost of the program prohibitive.

Workshop Tuition Assistance

This scholarship is available in two ways:

1) **Endow Tuition Rebate.** For women who wish to join an Endow group but find the material fees prohibitive. This fund



will reimburse half the cost in order to make it more affordable to join.

2) Workshop Tuition Scholarship. For adults already in lay ministry who wish to participate in workshops for continuing education. This fund will pay for the workshop registration fee.

College Scholarship

For college juniors or seniors who are engaged in a course of study related to Theology or Pastoral Ministry who plan to go on to serve in parish or diocesan ministry after graduation. This fund will award up to \$1000 per year for two years. Applicants must meet minimum




requirements, including having at least a C+ average, being enrolled in an undergraduate program in degree Theology or Pastoral Ministry, and having the

intention of serving the Church upon graduation.
