#### **NATIONAL EUCHARISTIC REVIVAL**

The Bishops of the United States are calling for a three-year grassroots revival of devotion and belief in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Eucharist. They believe that God wants to see a **movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist—and sent out in mission “for the life of the world.”**

#### **KEYNOTE SPEAKERS...**



**Fr. Tom Margevičius**, who serves as director of the Office of Worship for the Archdiocese of Saint Paul & Minneapolis and as Sacramental Minister for Latinos in St. Dominic Parish in Northfield. An Ohio native, he came to Minnesota to serve with NET Ministries and was a founding member of the Companions of Christ priestly fraternity in the Archdiocese. He previously served almost two decades as a professor of liturgy and homiletics at The St. Paul Seminary.



**Kristin Bird**, who serves as the Executive Director of *Burning Hearts Disciples*, an apostolate "to further the Catholic Church's call to form disciples through the New Evangelization." She is a popular speaker, podcast co-host (the *Transforming Parishes, Transforming Lives* podcast) and consultant with a long history of serving Church organizations to facilitate deeper discipleship and conversion. She describes herself as “a wife, mother, disciple of Jesus, and on fire Catholic.”
