


## For Freedom Christ has set us free!

## Core Movements of the Kerygma

- 1. God is love and has created me for relationship with Him.
- 2. I have broken my relationship with God by my sin.
- 3. Jesus restores my relationship with God through his life, death, resurrection.
- 4. Jesus invites me to trust him, to turn from sin and to give my life to Him.
- 5. Jesus has poured the Holy Spirit into my heart to bring me to new life in His Church and sends His Church on mission so that others can experience new life.
