





The Great Pause of 2020






Of those aged between 25-64, between 1999-2017:

Reflection questions:


How are we raising up the next generation of saints from this time?

Are we spending more time on triaging existing ministries or leaning in to where the Holy Spirit is moving us?






KERYGMA (from the Greek *keryssein,* to proclaim, and *keryx,* herald) refers to the initial and essential proclamation of the gospel message. The word appears nine times in the New Testament: once in Matthew (12:41), once in Mark (16:20), once in Luke (11:32), and six times in the letters of St. Paul (Rom. 16:25; 1 Cor. 1:21, 2:4, 15:14; 2 Tim. 4:17; and Titus 1:3)



- 5. Jesus has poured the Holy Spirit into my heart to bring me to new life in His Church and sends His Church on mission so that others can experience new life.


