


# March RCIA NEWSLETTER



A very big THANK YOU to all the parishes that participated in the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion on March 6th at Queen of Angels Church in Austin.

We currently have over 140 individuals from 25 parishes/parish clusters preparing to be received/initiated into the Catholic Church. Our diocesan celebration of the Rite of Election and Call to Continuing Conversion included many of these catechumens (who are now the "elect") and candidates, along with their godparents and sponsors, from across the diocese. It was a joy to see so many come together to celebrate the growth and progress they have made in their faith journey thus far.

Bishop Quinn's homily emphasized the great gift that the catechumens and candidates are for our communities and diocese; and assured those preparing for the sacraments of initiation of his prayers as they journey towards the Easter Vigil.
