## **Congress approves CARES Act updates**

Today, Friday, March 27, 2020, Congress passed the Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act. The Act includes a provision that allows all over-the-counter products [drugs and medicines] to be qualified as medical expenses. Menstruation care products have also been added as an additional over-the-counter category. The Act also includes a safe harbor, which allows a health plan to cover any telehealth service without a deductive requirement for plans beginning on or before December 31, 2020.

You probably won't be able to use your debit card to make these purchases until about October. You can contact Further if you have questions on some over-the-counter products (drugs and medicines) that may be covered. You will need to file for reimbursement by accessing your online Further account.
