<u>Reader</u>: For the poor, the homeless, and all who are in need: that they may receive love, respect, and the material assistance they need. We pray to the Lord....

<u>Reader</u>: For all those facing an unexpected pregnancy: that they may listen for the Lord's voice and follow Him with trust, and that the peace of Christ may fill their hearts. We pray to the Lord....

<u>Reader</u>: For all women, men, and family members suffering from the effects of abortion: that they may know the Lord's tender love and His healing presence. We pray to the Lord...

<u>Reader</u>: For those who are ill: that they may they draw strength from the Sacred Heart of Jesus, who is always with us in our suffering. We pray to the Lord...

<u>Reader</u>: For parents who have lost a child through miscarriage, and for families who have lost a child through illness or injury: that in their darkness they may know the comfort and hope of Christ. We pray to the Lord...

<u>Reader</u>: For our elected officials: that in their leadership and public service, they may respect and honor the dignity of each person. We pray to the Lord...

<u>Leader</u>: Let us pray together in the words the Lord has taught us. *All: Our Father...* 

Leader: Father and Maker of all, you adorn all creation with splendor and beauty, and fashion human lives in your image and likeness. Awaken in every heart reverence for the work of your hands, and renew among your people a readiness to nurture and sustain your precious gift of life. Grant this through our Lord Jesus Christ, your Son, who lives and reigns with you in the unity of the Holy Spirit, One God forever and ever.
